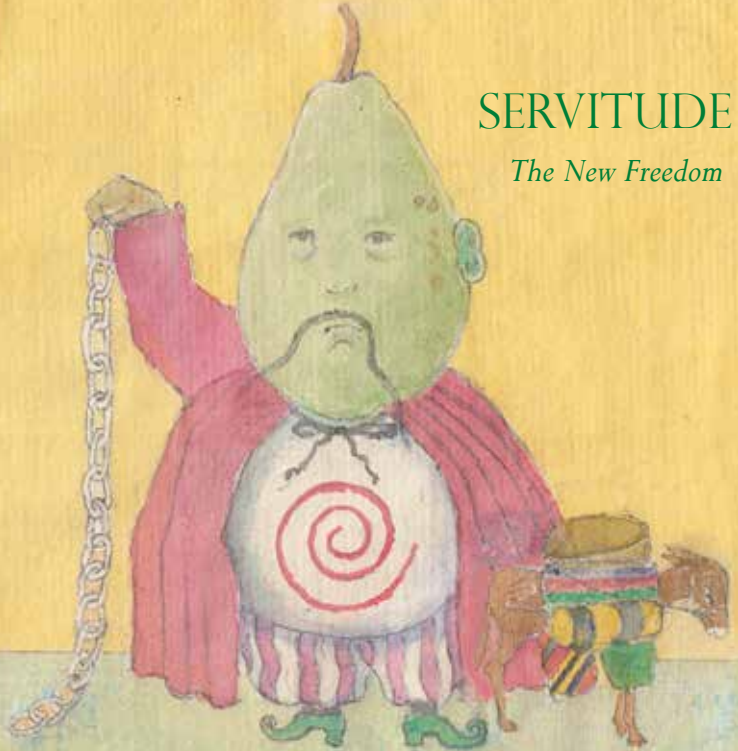

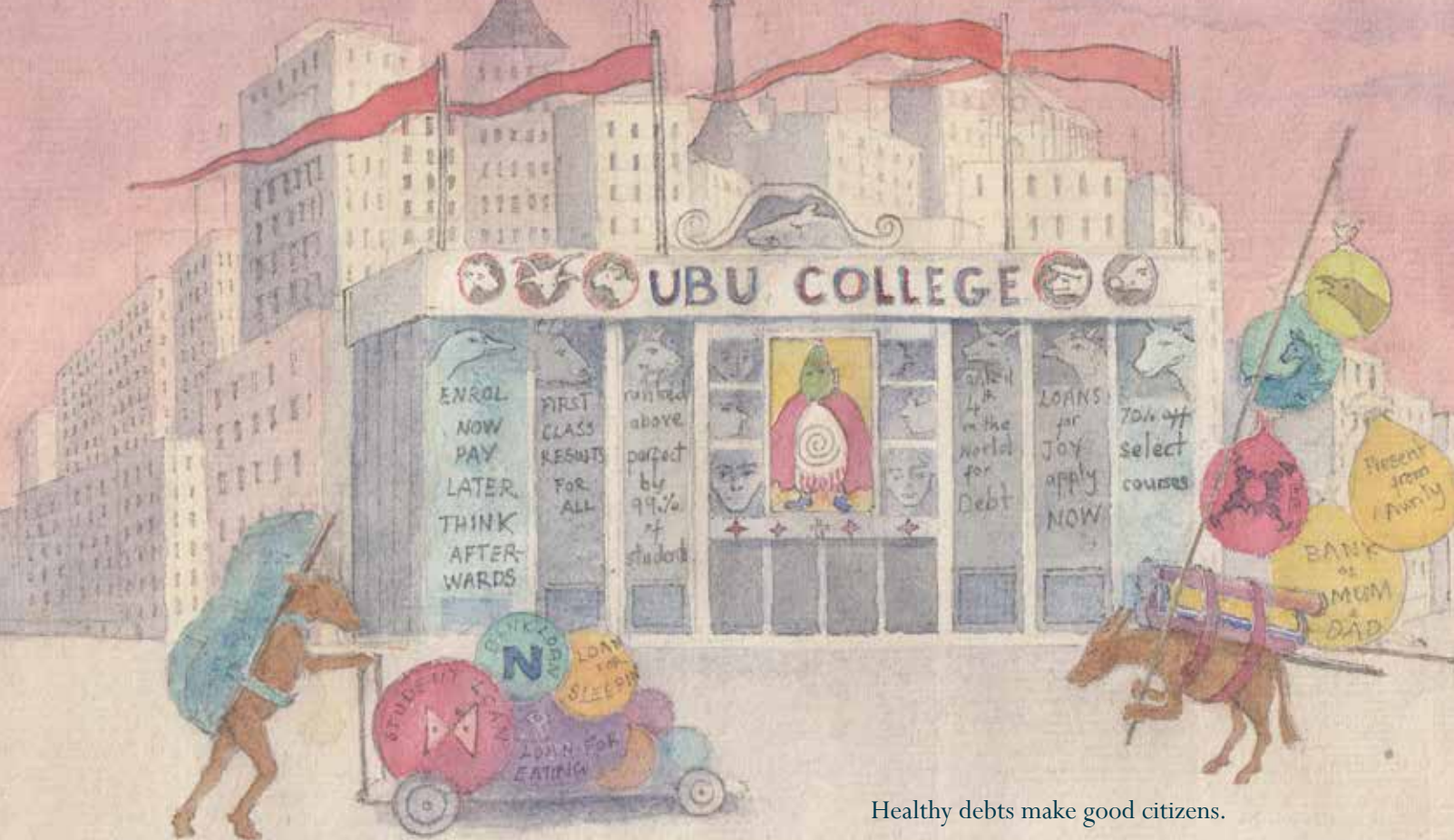

Throwing away our fun clothes



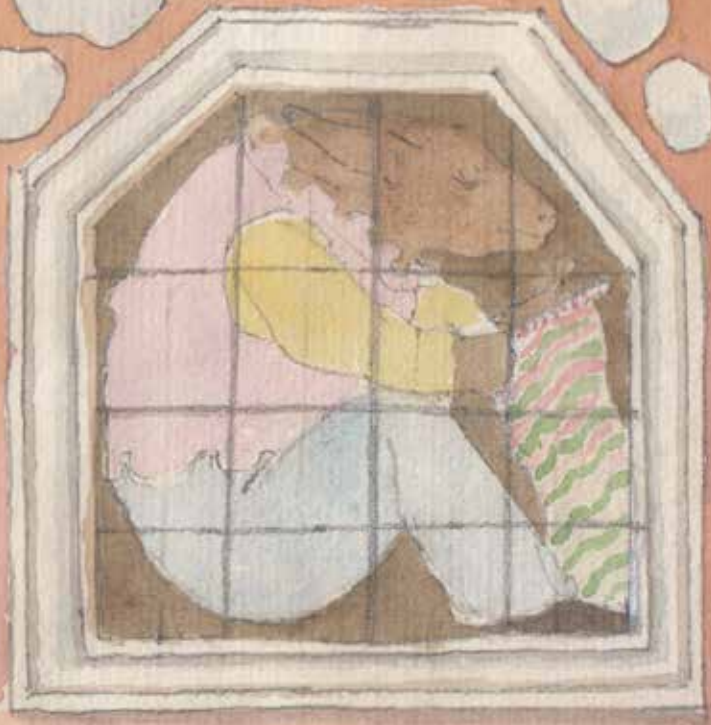
